Training periods (2021–2025):

One week training in each module.

- Module 1: 16 to 22 August 2021 (Poland)
- Module 2: 17 to 24 June 2023 (Latvia)
- Module 3: 20 to 26 June 2022 (online)
- Module 4: 17 to 23 June 2024 (Russia)
- Module 5: 16 to 22 June 2025 (Russia)

Project work after complete all modules training for certification:

- At the end of the further education a thesis must be written. It should be an independent examination on a medical-pharmaceutical topic.
- 100 hours tutoring have to be done.





Module 1	Four elements; Tria principia; the four members of the human being; Sal/Mercury/Sulfur; functional organization of the human being; from the image of the plant to the clinical picture to the remedy; Equisetum; Ferrum-Quartz (Biodoron, Kephalodoron); health and disease; potentization (in the liquid) (WALA/Weleda, etc.); salutogenesis.							
Module 2	Heat processes (practice and therapeutic aim); rhythmic methods (WALA/Rh); stabilized processes (syrups/Glycerin); potentization (in the solid) (WALA/Weleda, etc.); the four ethers (ether species), Apis/Formica, e.g. Cardiodoron (Digestio); decoct (fruit); syrup.							
Module 3	Metals/minerals; planets; mirror production; vegetabilized metals; practice: external/internal treatment of metal mirrors, e.g. "Spiegelfolie".							
Module 4	Compositions; practice: Aurum / Lavandula comp.; copper ointment red; Dorone e.g., Hepatodoron, etc.; Organ preparations (video); Antimon / Kal. Aceticum comp., Galenic e.g.; external applications (gels, ointments, cremes), globuli, oils, tbl, trit.; from the substance to the medicinal product, e.g. with a local plant (R&D).							
Module 5	Mode of action of the Anthroposophic Medicine; Limestone (Ca); Silica (quartz); Mineral compositions after the image of a healing plant; pastoral pharmacy; Olibanum comp. / Cinis Capsallae comp.; quality control aspects for medicinal products (pharmacopoeia); regulatory; best practice; magistral preparation; APC, Ph Helv., Ph. Eur.


